Rules & Regulations

- 1. Entries: are accepted via email to info@lotusshowstables.com or on-line at www.horseshowing.com
- 2. Post Entries: Entries close at noon the day before each show starts. All entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$25 post entry fee.
- 3. Fees: All entries must pay a \$25 Office Fee, \$15 Grounds Fee and \$3 USHJA Outreach Fee. Classes will be \$30 each unless otherwise noted. No Scratch Fee. A \$50 non-showing horse fee will be charged to any horses on the grounds that are not entered in the horse show.
- 4. Horse Show Office: Open 1 hour prior to the start of the show and closes 1 hour after completion of the show.
- 5. **Back Numbers:** will not be issued without a valid form of payment on file in the show office. This includes all signatures on the entry blank, emergency contact information and a valid form of payment. No one will be allowed to show or school without a number.
- 6. **Payment:** Entries can be paid with Cash, Check, Venmo, or Credit Card. Credit card and Venmo transactions will be assessed a 4% convenience fee and for credit cards, a current credit card authorization form must be filled out.
- 7. Hunter classes: will be judged based on performance and soundness. Any additional specifications will be noted
- 8. **Hunter Championships:** Championship and Reserve Ribbons will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points performing over a regulation hunter course. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive points for ribbons won in an under saddle class.
- 9. Jumper classes: For all ties other than first, time will decide.
- 10. **Prize Money**: will be applied to show accounts. If additional prize money is owed, it will be mailed within 30 days using the information provided on the entry blank. All prize money checks must be cashed within 30 days of issue, or will not be honored. Prize money will only be paid out if a valid name, address and tax payer id number has been reported to the show. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank.
- 11. Prize Money Distribution: 30%, 22%, 15%, 12%, 11%, 10%. Classes with prize money will require 6 entries for prize money to be distributed.
- 12. Schooling: Back numbers must be worn to school. Schooling will be permitted only in the areas provided by show management and only over designated practice jumps therein. Unauthorized schooling will be cause for dismissal from the show grounds.
- 13. **Cancel/Combine:** Management reserves the right to cancel, to combine, or to divide any class or classes in the best interest of the show, and adjust the time schedule if in the opinion of the management circumstances dictate such changes.
- 14. Limiting Entries: Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section, or division.
- 15. **Discourtesy**: Any discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of an owner, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his/her entry and other fees.
- 16. Attire: Exhibitors must be in the proper riding attire and wear USEF approved protective headgear at all times when mounted on the show grounds.
- 17. Specs: Classes/divisions designated as NJHSA, NJPHA, M&S, TIP, USHJA Outreach, Colonial Classic & PEL will be run in accordance with current specifications.
- 18. **Memberships**: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the current memberships necessary to accrue points/compete in any classes offered herein. This will include NJHSA, NJPHA, M&S, USHJA Outreach, PEL, TIP, Colonial Classic and any other associations that may apply.
- 19. Checks: A processing fee of \$75 will be charged for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be refused from participating in future Lotus Show Series events.
- 20. Dogs: No dogs allowed at Lotus Show Stables. Please leave your dogs home!
- 21. **Responsibility:** Lotus Show Stables will, in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of entry to the show grounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood, and accepted. Additionally each exhibitor shall hold Lotus Show Stables harmless for any illness, loss, or accident which may occur by fire or otherwise.
- 22. Checkout: Any open invoices will be closed by office staff at the end of the show with the method of payment holding the entry. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to review their bill and resolve any discrepancies within one hour of the show ending. If disputes are not negotiated within this time frame the bill stands without further review.
- 23. Changes: Schedule and rings may change at management's discretion, every effort will be made to post updates in a timely manner.
- 24. Errors: While every effort has been made to avoid errors in this publication, Lotus Show Stables, LLC and its management assume no liability to anyone for errors. Should a question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision is final.
- 25. Hold Harmless: Lotus Show Stables, LLC, it's employees, owners, management or staff, or any member of the show committee or staff will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.
